## ENGLISH FOR THE FUTURE, BRIGHTON

<p><b>30th June</b></p>	<p><b>Brighton Royal Pavilion &amp; Shopping</b> This exotic palace, built as a seaside home for King George IV, features a unique design with Indian-style domes and towers. Students will see the spectacular Chinese-inspired decorations and royal furnishings.</p>
<p><b>7th July</b></p>	<p><b>Brighton Museum, Seafront and Shopping</b> One of the most important and eclectic collections in the UK, with exciting interactive displays covering fashion and style and 20th century art and design. Afterwards, students will go for a stroll along the seafront and explore the quirky shops in Brighton North Laines.</p>
<p><b>14th July</b></p>	<p><b>Brighton Pier, Seafront &amp; Shopping</b> Brighton Pier is the biggest attraction in the South East of England with exciting rides such as the Ghost Train, Crazy Mouse and Rollercoaster. Built by the Victorians and opened in 1899, the pier is one of the most visited tourist attractions in the UK and has been offering lots of fun to this day.</p>
<p><b>21st July</b></p>	<p><b>Brighton Royal Pavilion &amp; Shopping</b> This exotic palace, built as a seaside home for King George IV, features a unique design with Indian-style domes and towers. Students will see the spectacular Chinese-inspired decorations and royal furnishings.</p>
<p><b>28th July</b></p>	<p><b>Brighton Museum, Seafront and Shopping</b> One of the most important and eclectic collections in the UK, with exciting interactive displays covering fashion and style and 20th century art and design. <p><b>4th August</b></p>	<p><b>Brighton Marina and Globalls Crazy Golf</b> Students will explore the bustling atmosphere of Brighton Marina, a premier waterfront destination with scenic harbour views. Afterward, the group will head to Globalls for an unforgettable round of glow-in-the-dark crazy golf, competing against friends in a vibrant, neon-lit world.</p>

<p><b>2nd July</b></p>	<p><b>London Museum Docklands and Canary Wharf</b> Students will discover the city's transformation from a Roman port to a global trading hub through immersive galleries and historical artifacts and experience the futuristic skyline of Canary Wharf, where they can marvel at some of Europe's tallest skyscrapers and shop in London's financial district.</p>
<p><b>9th July</b></p>	<p><b>London: Frameless Immersive Art Experience</b> Frameless is the largest permanent multi-sensory experience in the UK. There are four galleries featuring masterpieces from some of the world's greatest artists, such as Monet, Van Gogh and Dali. Afterwards, students will explore Oxford Street - London's most iconic shopping destination.</p>
<p><b>16th July</b></p>	<p><b>London: Tate Modern and Southbank Walking Tour</b> Students will immerse themselves in the world of contemporary art at the Tate Modern and embark on a Southbank Walking Tour, taking in London's most famous sights including the London Eye, Shakespeare's Globe Theatre and the vibrant street performers along the River Thames.</p>
<p><b>23rd July</b></p>	<p><b>London: Kew Gardens and Richmond Walk</b> Students will wander through the world-renowned Kew Gardens, home to the planet's most diverse collection of living plants and stunning Victorian glasshouses. Afterward, they will enjoy a scenic Richmond Walk along the banks of the River Thames in one of London's most charming villages.</p>
<p><b>30th July</b></p>	<p><b>London: Cable Cars &amp; The O2 Arena Shopping</b> London Cable Cars - London's sustainable commuting option, gliding 90 metres above the River Thames, offer spectacular views of the city's iconic skyline. Afterward, students will explore the massive O2 Arena complex.</p>
<p><b>6th August</b></p>	<p><b>London: Covent Garden</b> Students will dive into the electric atmosphere of Covent Garden, where world-famous street performers and musicians entertain crowds in the historic 19th century piazza. Students will have the chance to explore Apple Market and its surrounding cobblestone streets.</p>



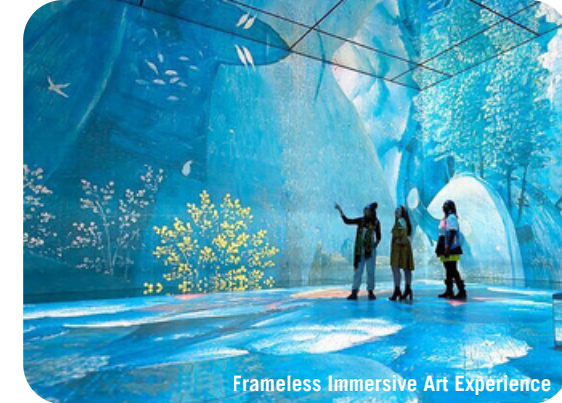

<p>4th July</p>	<p><b>London: British Museum &amp; Oxford Street</b> This trip offers the perfect London experience: a morning immersed in the ancient secrets of the British Museum examining world-famous historical objects like the Rosetta Stone and the Elgin Marbles, followed by an afternoon of high-energy shopping in London's busiest shopping district.</p>
<p>11th July</p>	<p><b>London: Thames River Cruise &amp; Westminster Walking Tour</b> A boat trip along the River Thames offers a clear view of landmarks like the Tower of London, the London Eye and Big Ben. This is followed by a walking tour of Parliament Square and Whitehall to see the Houses of Parliament and the guards at Horse Guards Parade.</p>
<p>18th July</p>	<p><b>London Eye &amp; Oxford Street</b> A 30-minute flight at 135 metres on the London Eye, the world's tallest observation wheel, provides a panoramic view of the city's skyline, followed by a walking tour to Oxford Street, Europe's busiest shopping road, to explore famous flagship stores like Selfridges.</p>
<p>25th July</p>	<p><b>London: Madame Tussauds &amp; Westminster Walking Tour</b> A visit to Madame Tussauds involves meeting lifelike wax figures of world-famous celebrities, sporting legends and the British Royal Family. This is followed by a walking tour of Westminster to see iconic London landmarks including Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament and Westminster Abbey.</p>
<p>1st August</p>	<p><b>London: British Museum &amp; Oxford Street</b> This trip offers the perfect London experience: a morning immersed in the ancient secrets of the British Museum examining world-famous historical objects like the Rosetta Stone and the Elgin Marbles, followed by an afternoon of high-energy shopping in London's busiest shopping district.</p>



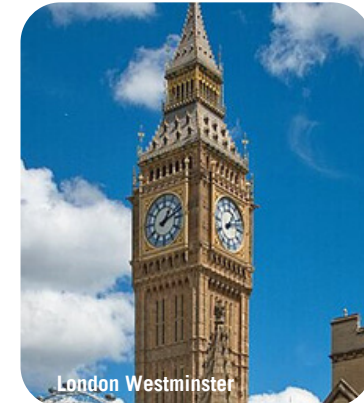

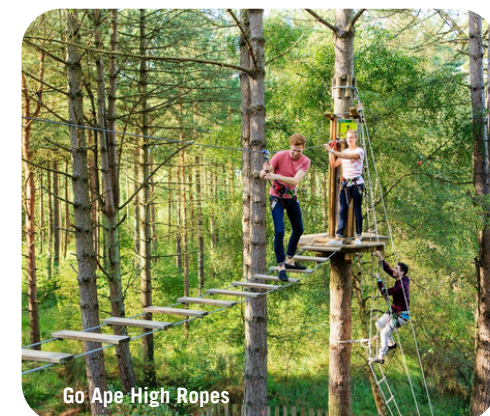

<p><b>5th July</b></p>	<p><b>Port Lympne Safari Park</b> A truck safari across the vast African and Asian reserves will allow the students to observe free-roaming animals like giraffes, zebras, rhinos, lions, tigers, gorillas, monkeys and bears. This is followed by a walking tour of the Gorilla Trail to see the world's largest collection of Western Lowland Gorillas.</p>
<p><b>12th July</b></p>	<p><b>Portsmouth Historic Dockyard &amp; Gunwharf Quays</b> A visit to Portsmouth Historic Dockyard involves exploring famous warships like the HMS Victory, Lord Nelson's flagship during the Battle of Trafalgar in 1805. The trip continues to Gunwharf Quays, a modern waterfront area where students can observe the Spinnaker Tower and explore the designer outlet shops.</p>
<p><b>19th July</b></p>	<p><b>Thorpe Park</b> A visit to the UK's most thrilling theme park with over 25 rides which involves experiencing some of the UK's tallest and fastest rollercoasters such as the Hyperia and the Swarm, getting soaked on the Tidal Wave, and discovering various immersive attractions.</p>
<p><b>26th July</b></p>	<p><b>Windsor Castle</b> A visit to the world's oldest and largest occupied castle includes a tour of the State Apartments, which are decorated with famous paintings and royal treasures. The excursion also features St George's Chapel, the burial place of many monarchs, and the opportunity to watch the Changing of the Guards.</p>
<p><b>2nd August</b></p>	<p><b>Go Ape Bedgebury Forest Adventures and High Ropes</b> Located in Bedgebury National Park, this trip involves navigating high-ropes, wobbly bridges and a 170-metre zip line through the tree canopy. Students will test their courage at the Treetop Challenge with its Tarzan swings.</p>
