Description

A Cambridge English: BI Preliminary qualification is accepted worldwide and shows that students have mastered the basics of English and now have practical language skills for everyday use. This exam is the logical step in your language-learning journey between Cambridge English: A2 Key and Cambridge English: B2 First. Students sit the exam in an exam centre authorised by Cambridge.
