

A CAMBRIDGE B1 Preliminary for Schools is an intermediate-level English language qualification accepted worldwide which shows that students have mastered the basics of English and now have practical language skills for everyday use. This exam is the logical step in students' language-learning journey between CAMBRIDGE A2 Key and CAMBRIDGE B2 First. Bede's Summer School prepare students for the 'for Schools' version of the exam, which is targeted at the same Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) level as CAMBRIDGE B1 Preliminary but with content aimed at school-age learners rather than adults.
