Little Explorers - Eastbourne

2nd July	Knockhatch Adventure Park There are thrilling rides, exciting indoor and outdoor play areas and a wildlife sanctuary, The Jungle Kingdom Zoo. See meerkats, otters and prairie dogs and explore the Jungle Splash area.
9th July	Cuckmere Haven Wildlife Walk Discover where the River Cuckmere meets the English Channel and see one of the most beautiful parts of the Sussex coastline. The beaches are shingle beneath the white chalk cliffs of the Seven Sisters.
16th July	Drusillas Zoo The zoo has more than 100 species of animals and there are rides on the Safari Express train, Hippopotobus, Flying Cheetahs and Rainforest Carousel. Play in the splash pad and follow the Zoolympics activity trail.
23rd July	Blackberry Farm There are lots of animals to see and to feed, small pet handling areas, a goat bridge, tractor rides, pony rides, about 20 playgrounds, trampolines, a mini ride-on, basketball, ball games, and so much more!
30th July	Eastbourne Miniature Steam Railway Adventure Park A steam train ride, crazy golf, a maze to get lost in and a playground plus a visit to 'Grandma's Garden'.
6th August	Herstmonceux Observatory The Observatory Science Centre located in Herstmonceux Castle was based here to take advantage of dark skies away from the light pollution of a city. Explore the Discovery Park and the Water Planet.
13th August	Knockhatch Adventure Park There are thrilling rides, exciting indoor and outdoor play areas and a wildlife sanctuary, The Jungle Kingdom Zoo. See meerkats, otters and prairie dogs and explore the Jungle Splash area.

5th July	<p>London: Paddington Bear Experience</p> <p>Experience the world of Paddington, and go on an exciting adventure to help the Brown family prepare for the Marmalade Day Festival. Start at the busy Paddington Station and jump on the train!</p>
12th July	<p>London: Science Museum</p> <p>One of the city's major attractions, explore displays from the Stone Age to the Space Age and beyond. Engineering, the Environment, Everyday Technology, Medicine and Astronomy are just some of the topics to be explored.</p>
19th July	<p>London: Thames River Cruise</p> <p>London's best sights seen from on board a river cruiser. The boat trip takes in London landmarks such as Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, London Eye and the Tower of London.</p>
26th July	<p>London: Natural History Museum</p> <p>The Natural History Museum is filled with fascinating exhibits. See the huge blue whale, the first T-Rex fossil ever discovered, meteorites from outer space and the largest gold nugget in the world. Experience the earthquake simulator and feel the room shake.</p>
2nd August	<p>London Zoo</p> <p>See wildlife from around the world in Regent's Park in central London. Enter Penguin Beach, Ninos Cove, Tiny Giants, Land of the Lions, Tiger Territory and the Dragon House.</p>
9th August	<p>London Eye</p> <p>At 135 metres, the London Eye is the world's tallest observation wheel. Experience breathtaking views of London from the iconic structure, learning about the city's landmarks and history during the ride.</p>

6th July	<p>Windsor Castle</p> <p>Almost 1,000 years old, and the largest home of the British Royal Family. See beautiful historical items from grand state rooms to paintings and experience British history in action watching the changing of the guard.</p>
