Finding Us

If you are coming to us by road, Eastbourne Preparatory School is situated on the seafront in Eastbourne, just at the foot of the South Downs. Eastbourne can be reached via the A22 (from London) or the A27 (from Brighton). On-street parking is available close to the school (charges apply). Bede's Summer School office is located in the main school building. You will need to ring the buzzer on arrival, or call the office on +44 1323 356698.

By rail, there are direct trains from London's Victoria train station and you should get off at Eastbourne. The journey will take about 1hr 30 mins. Pay attention because often, the train divides at Haywards Heath, so you need to make sure you are sitting in the correct part of the train. From Eastbourne train station, the school is about a 15-minute taxi ride away.

If coming to us by the Channel Tunnel, Ashford international train station terminal is approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes away by road.

Smoking is not permitted anywhere on campus.

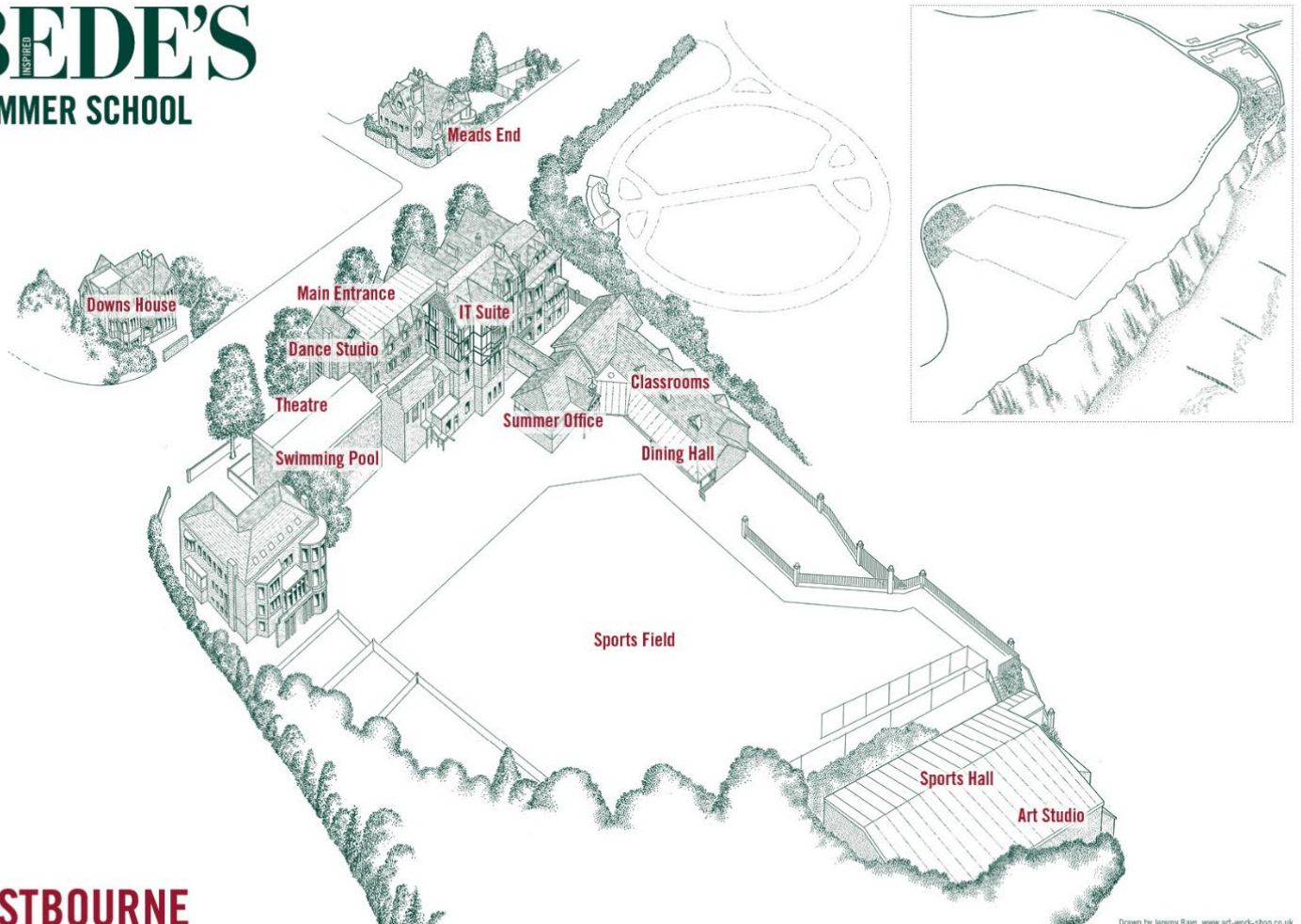
Security
