Finding Us

If you are travelling by road, Windlesham House School is situated 6 miles (10 km) north of Worthing on the A24. You can park in the visitor's parking area in front of the main building. The Summer School office is located in the main building. The Summer School entrance is clearly signposted and you will need to ring the bell on arrival or ask a staff member for Bede's Summer School office.

By rail, there are direct trains from London's Victoria train station and you should get off at Worthing. The journey will take about 1 hour 30 minutes. From Worthing train station, Windlesham is about a 20-minute taxi ride.

If coming to us by Eurostar, St Pancras International train station terminal is approximately 2 hours 15 minutes away by road.

Please follow the speed limits when driving on campus and remember that use of mobile phones while driving is strictly prohibited.

Smoking is not permitted anywhere on campus.

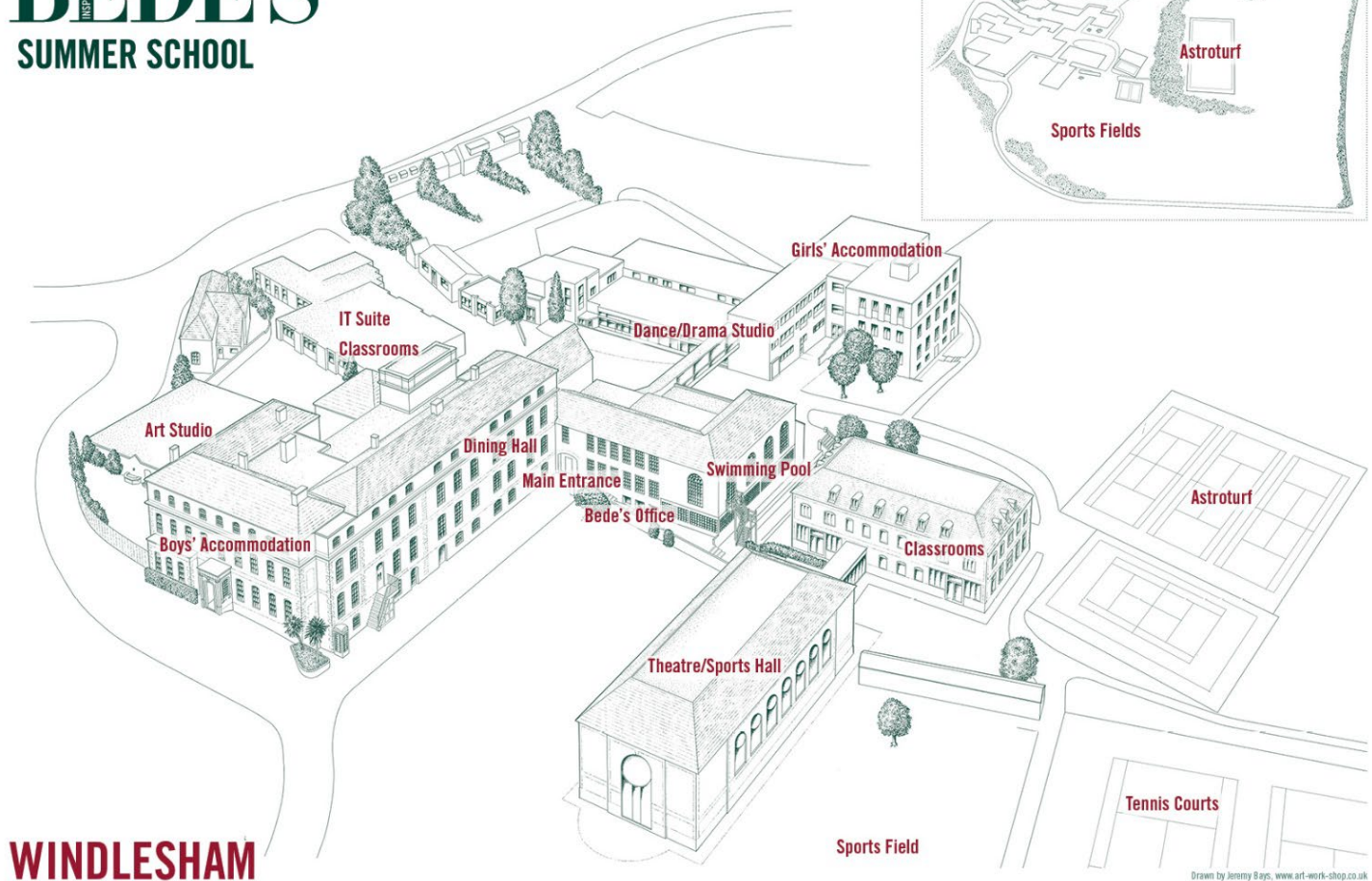
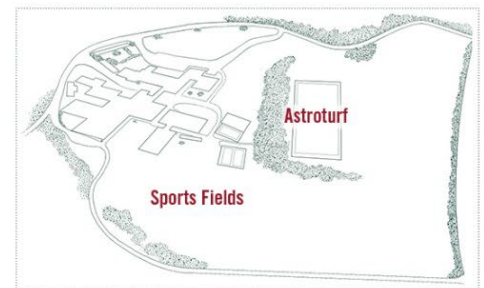
Security
