Finding Us

If you are travelling by road, Bede's Senior School is situated in the village of Upper Dicker 1 mile to the west of the A22 (London to Eastbourne road) and 4 miles north of the A27. We are 10 miles from Eastbourne, 8 miles from Lewes and 3 miles from Hailsham.

You can park in the visitor's carpark (signed). Once parked, report to the Porter's Lodge and ask for the Summer School. If there is nobody at the Porter's Lodge, wait outside and telephone the Summer School office on 01323 356703 and a member of the team will come and meet you.

By rail, there are direct trains from London's Victoria train station and you should get off at Polegate train station. The journey will take 1 hour 20 mins. From there, the school is a short taxi ride away. We do not recommend using Berwick train station because although closer, there is no taxi rank.

If coming to us by the Channel Tunnel, Ashford international train station terminal is approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes away by road.

Please follow the speed limits when driving on campus and remember that use of mobile phones while driving is strictly prohibited.

Smoking is not permitted anywhere on campus.



Security
